## Gordon's London Dry Gin 37.5% vol - £2.50

---

Gordon's contains juniper berries, carefully selected from the pick of each year's crop. These are gently shaken from the tree and then stored for two years to intensify the oils and mellow the flavours. As well as juniper berries our recipe includes coriander seeds, angelica root, liquorice, orris root, orange and lemon peel. Coriander gives the dry and citrus taste. Angelica is the magic ingredient that ties together the other botanicals to give a long and complex flavour.



## Plymouth Gin 41.2% vol - £2.70

---

Plymouth Gin is a true original. Since 1793 its unique recipe of botanicals has been made to the highest standards in the same distillery in the very heart of the historical city of Plymouth, on England's South West coast. It's these factors that have resulted in our particularly English gin becoming as famous and well travelled as those who first tasted it.



## Bombay Sapphire London Dry Gin 40% vol - £2.70

---

The creation of Bombay Sapphire is truly unique. Whilst ordinary gins boil their botanicals directly in the spirit to achieve their flavour, the taste of Bombay Sapphire is created through the Vapour Infusion process. The 10 precious botanicals used in our gin are held separate from the spirit in perforated copper baskets, and when the heated vapours rise, the distinctive flavour of the botanicals are released. The result? A complex aromatic liquid that delivers a broader, more balanced flavour.



## Sipsmith London Dry Gin 41.6% vol - £3.00

---

The quintessential expression traditional London Dry Gin. Bold, complex and aromatic perfect for a G&T. Ten carefully selected botanicals from around the globe to make our London Dry Gin; Macedonian juniper berries, Bulgarian coriander seed, French angelica root, Spanish liquorice root, Italian orris root, Spanish ground almond, Chinese cassia bark, Madagascan cinnamon, Sevillian orange peel and Spanish lemon peel.



## Hendrick's Gin 41.4% vol - £3.20

---

Hendrick's wondrous botanical signature consists of flowers, roots, fruits, and seeds from the world over. They function to complement and set the stage for our delicious duet of infusions: rose petal and cucumber. No other gin tastes like Hendrick's because no other gin is made like Hendrick's. We infuse our gin with the remarkable Bulgarian Rosa Damascena and specially selected cucumbers from the finest producers.



## Tanqueray No. Ten 47.3% vol - £3.30

In 2000, after 170 years of distilling expertise, Tanqueray No. Ten was born. Tanqueray No. Ten is handcrafted in small batches using fresh citrus fruits (grapefruits, oranges and limes), camomile flowers and other hand selected botanicals which give it a uniquely smooth, clean, refreshing taste.

## *Pinkster Agreeably British Gin 37.5% vol - £3.20*

---

Pinkster is a small-batch premium gin that launched in summer 2013. Made with hand-steeped fresh, locally grown raspberries at our Cambridge headquarters, Pinkster is deliciously dry, with a hint of raspberry and the smoothest of finishes. Pinkster is the brainchild of bean counter and ginmeister Stephen Marsh who experimented for several years at home, foisting creations upon unsuspecting friends. He didn't set out to make a pink drink but after working his way through an entire fruit bowl, he discovered raspberry delivered the best flavour.



## *Tarquin's Gin 42% vol - £3.20*

---

A contemporary take on a classic London Dry Gin, we use fragrant handpicked Devon violets and fresh orange zest to deliver an aromatic sensation unlike any other. We like to think the result is comparable to stumbling upon a beautiful orange blossom in the middle of a crisp, dry pine forest. Only the best and most pure spirit (the heart) makes it into Tarquin's Gin, which is diluted to bottling strength at 42% with Cornish spring water.



## *Conker Dry Gin 40% vol - £3.30*

---

Unique and intricate gin with ten select botanicals, distilled and bottled at Dorset's first gin distillery, nestled in the backstreets of Bournemouth. Whilst still a proper classic gin, led by a dry Macedonian juniper heart, the subtle incorporation of the Dorset notes of elderberries, samphire and handpicked New Forest gorse flowers brings bright and refreshing lighter notes to Conker.



## *Salcombe Gin London Dry Gin 44% vol - £3.50*

---

Salcombe Gin is a delicious, super smooth, hand distilled gin made from thirteen carefully selected botanicals distilled with the finest English wheat spirit and blended with pure Dartmoor water to produce a gin of extraordinary quality. Unique and elegant citrus forward flavour that is refreshing yet perfectly balanced with the botanicals working in harmony. A precise blend of grapefruit, lemons and limes to give the gin a refreshing citrus edge. Liquorice adds a touch of sweetness and green cardamom helps lengthen the finish.



## *Monkey 47 Dry Gin 47% vol - £4.00*

---

Monkey 47 Gin is distilled in the Schwarzwald (Black Forest) region of Germany. The '47' in the name comes from both the 47 botanicals used and the 47% ABV. Meanwhile the 'monkey' element refers to the story of a British Air Force Commander who help rebuild Berlin Zoo after the war and later opening a Black Forest guesthouse called 'The Wild Monkey' at which he served his own gin. Monkey 47 Gin founder discovered this story and was inspired to create a new gin, using records of the original recipe as inspiration, such as including lingonberries, cranberries and spruce shoots amongst the botanicals.
